

## TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847 SECTION 21

WYCHAVON DISTRICT COUNCIL (being a District Council for the purposes of Section 2 of the Local Government Act 1972) ("the Council") is exercising its powers pursuant to Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847.

WHEREAS the Council is satisfied that traffic should be restricted as hereinafter provided to enable the VJ DAY 70<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION to take place.

NOW THEREFORE the Council pursuant to its said powers HEREBY ORDERS that on SATURDAY 15<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 2015 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the following locations within BIRLINGHAM during the following times except at the discretion of the West Mercia Police:

THE AVENUE BIRLINGHAM
FROM JUNCTION WITH
CHURCH STREET TO
JUNCTION WITH RECTORY
LANE

9-00AM TO 7-00PM

The Police have stipulated the following:-

Road closures must be effected with the correct signs and barriers as required by Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual with a signed diversion route in place where appropriate. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that this is complied with.

Police Officers will not be provided to assist with any element of this event including traffic control, unless the organiser has made a request for special Police services to the Divisional Planning Office at Worcester Police Station.

The organiser is reminded that they are responsible for the event in its entirety which will include implementing, managing and staffing of all road closures forming part of this event.

Event Marshals have no power to stop or direct traffic, must be over 18 years of age and must wear appropriate reflective safety clothing.

Access must be maintained for emergency service vehicles at all times.
